- Discourage unfair play and argumentative behaviours.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and celebrating the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Support the advice and learning outcomes of the Coach.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Help your child promote a healthy lifestyle outside of a session.
