

## **Code of Conduct – Players**

Players are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with **Steve Farey – Head Coach**.

A player at a Safari Badminton session is expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Players must play within the rules; listen to and respect the Coach at all times; respect officials and their decisions.
- Respect Safari Badminton equipment and report any damages.
- All players must respect the rights, dignity and value of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Players should promote and demonstrate a supportive attitude towards others at a session.
- Players should demonstrate good time keeping when arriving for a session to ensure they maximise the benefits of attending the whole session.
- Players must wear suitable kit and clothing for all sessions;

  - T-shirt
  - Shorts or sports skirt
  - Tracksuit trousers
  - Jumper
  - No outdoor shoes, jeans or caps
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- Players should promote their own healthy lifestyle both at a session and in day to day life.
